The carparks are out of bounds for students at all times.

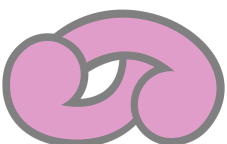
The carpark by the large bins is **NOT** for whanau or a drop off area, it is staff only. Do not stop in the disabled drop off zone.
