## **LEVEL 2 GUIDELINES**

Thank you, everyone, for supporting our guidelines and rules during the first stage of Level 2. Acting upon advice from the Secretary of Education, we will be easing (slightly) some of our health and safety procedures, from Tuesday 2 June:

### **School Entry**

Students will be able to enter the school from 8:00 am each morning. As per our normal procedures, they must stay down on the bottom courts until the 8:30 am bell rings. On entry to class, they will wash/sanitise hands. With the weather being coldish, we would prefer that students do not enter the grounds too early.

### **School Assembly**

Our Thursday assemblies will start on Thursday 4 June. Whanau are welcome to attend. Sanitise hands on entry to the hall and sit 1m apart.

### **Parents in Classrooms**

Whanau must come to the office, sign the contact register and sanitise hands before moving around the school. Please keep visits to classrooms to a minimum.

### **Go Bananaz**

We will be allowing the Go Bananaz programme to restart and other visiting groups. We will be mindful of health and safety at all times.

### **Van Run**

The morning pick up and afternoon drop off of students will also start on Tuesday 2 June.

### **Other Programmes**

At this stage, we will not be taking students out of school. We will monitor the situation and let you know when/if things change.

## **SCHOOL CAMP 2021 CANCELLED**

The Board of Trustees has made the very difficult decision to cancel the 2021 Year 5 & 6 camp. This year, we are part of the \$150 school donation scheme, however, this does not cover the approximately \$400 per student cost of the Auckland camp. Under New Zealand law, we can only request that whanau pay camp costs. The Board is not able to finance full or part camp costs.

We will be reviewing the school Education Outside the Classroom programme and hope to include more visits to local events and activities.
