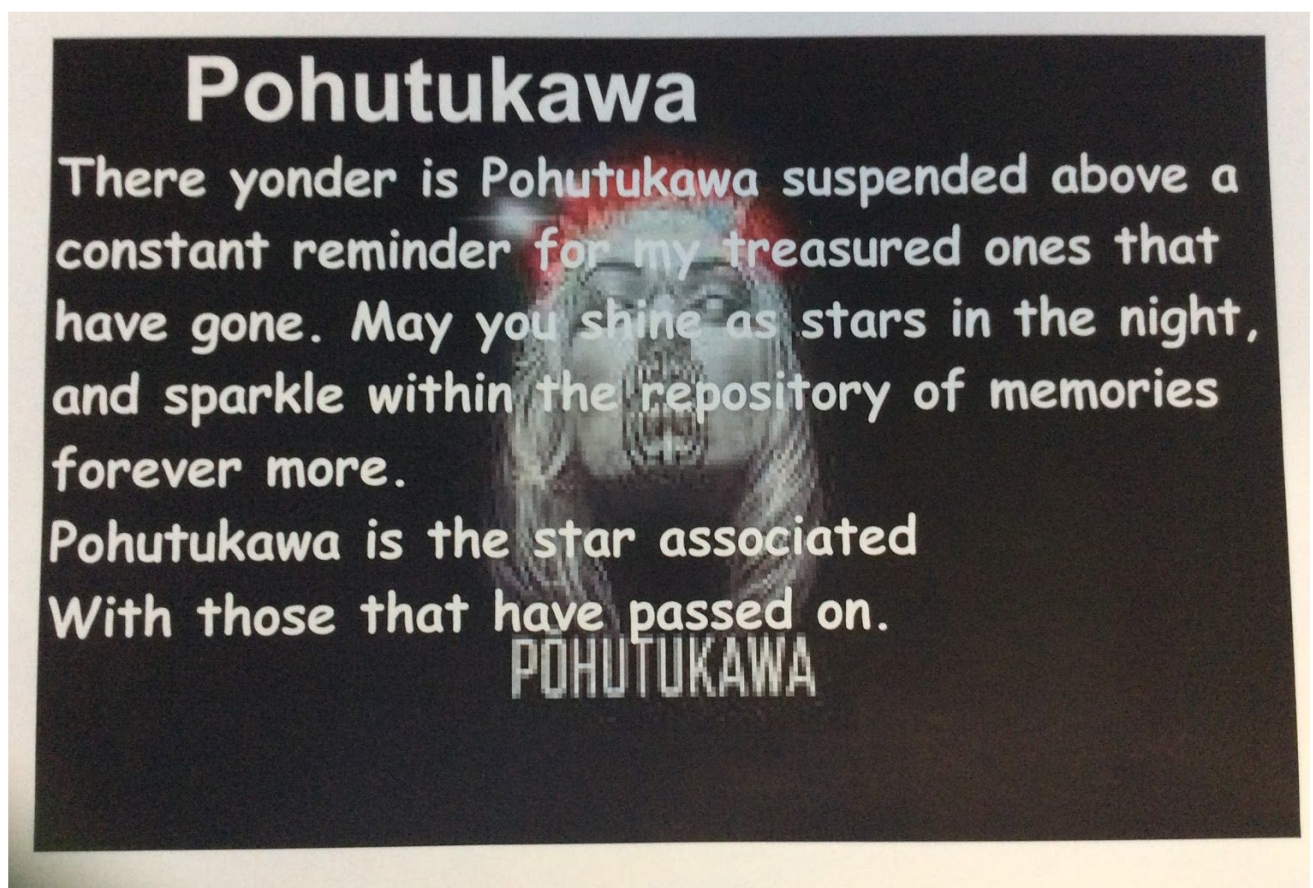

ASSEMBLY

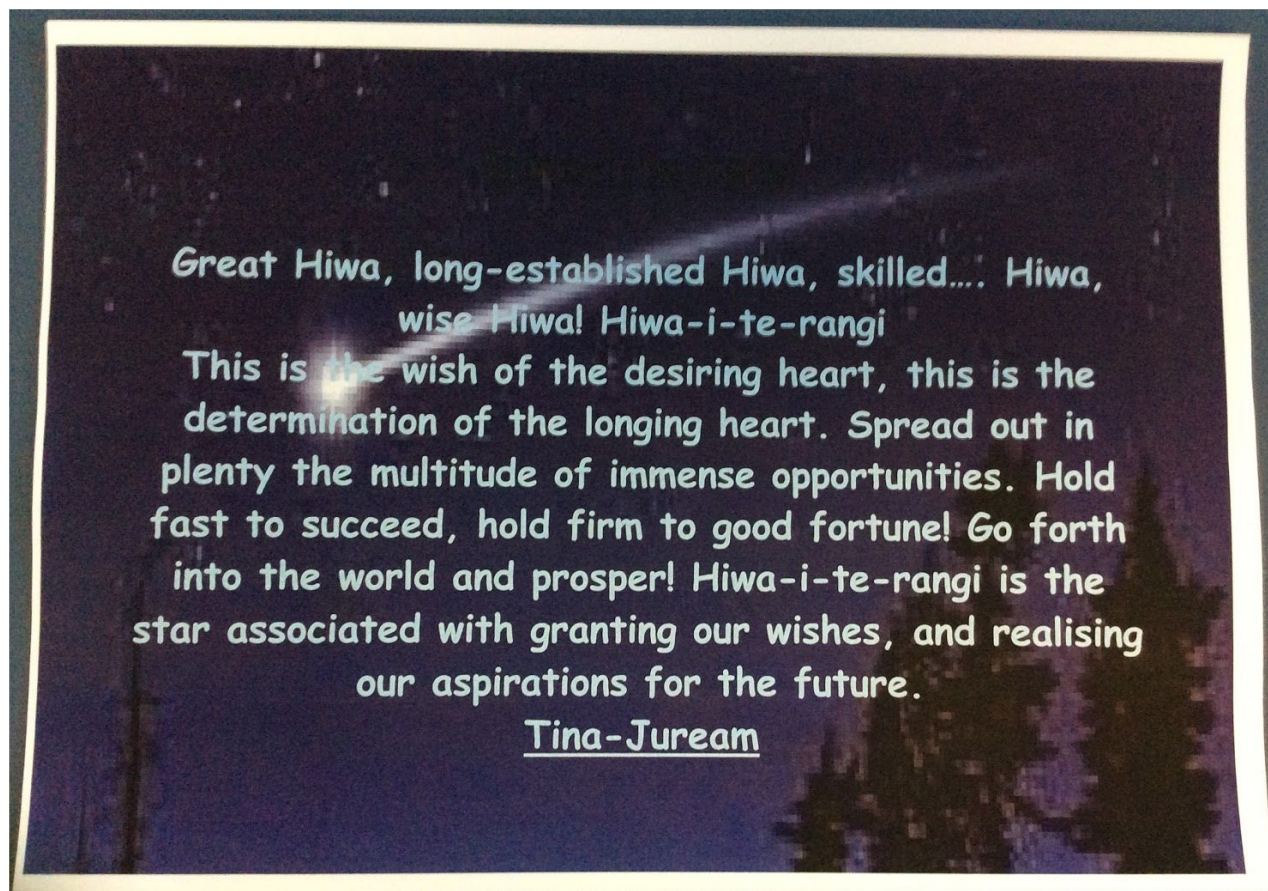
Assembly this week will be hosted by the Aquabot team and Matua Clayton. We hope you can join us in the hall at 2:30 pm.
